Technology Agreement

During the summer, campers will be using school technology devices and participating in BYOD (Bring Your Own Device). Campers will be allowed to bring, iPads, tablets, or other approved devices to be enjoyed during scheduled tech time. We want to make sure that everyone is aware of the boundaries of acceptable behavior for this privilege. It is important to have rules for your child's safety and the safety of the various technology devices that will be in use at Camp White Rock North.

Please review the rules with your child, then sign and date the bottom of this agreement. Without written agreement/consent, your child will not be allowed to participate in technology related activities.

Internet, Devices Guidelines and Expectations

- Protect your username and password from others.
- Do not use other peoples' passwords
- Respect the equipment and act responsibly at all times.
- Do not destroy, modify or abuse devices in any way.
- Do not delete or add apps without parent / teacher permission.
- Notify an adult if you find inappropriate information of any kind on your device.
- Be polite and courteous.
- Always use appropriate language; do not use slang, or inappropriate words.
- Do not copy/paste any information with parent / teacher permission.
- Respect copyrights.
- If you are not sure if it's OK, ask a parent / teacher.
- Do not give out any personal information over the internet (including, but not limited to: your name, birthdate, address, telephone number, or any other information that could be used to find out who / where you are.)
- All websites and game sites must be teacher approved.
- No sharing BYOD devices.
- Intentional damage to school property/devices is subject to repair/replacement fee assessed to the responsible party.

Choosing not to follow these rules may result in full removal of technology privileges. Technology used correctly can make learning a rich and fun experience. Help us keep this privilege.
